

## ***Drama in the Schools – 2011***

- **A 40-minute improvisation performance** in the gym for grades 4 to 8. This interactive four-actor presentation involves on stage student participation, audience involvement and lots of fun.
- **Up to 4 individual concurrent classroom workshops.** Led by a Theatre Orangeville actor, each 40-minute workshop features favourite theatre games that develop drama skills and involve the entire class\*. (\*one class, up to approximately 30 students per workshop, please)
- **A Classroom (Level I) Theatre Kit** is designed to assist teachers to meet the expectations of the *Ontario Drama Curriculum*. (Laminated cards, instructions and even a bicycle horn!)
- **An Instructional DVD** of our best loved theatre games. This DVD is a companion to both the classroom workshops and the Level I Theatre Kit. The DVD demonstrates the classroom workshop games, illustrates stage techniques and explains how the games fulfill the expectations of the *Ontario Drama Curriculum*: role/character, relationship, time and place, tension, focus and emphasis.
